- 13 Concha y Toro Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile** \$ 17.50
 Dry, fruity wine with apple and citrus flavours and a hint of melon. half bottle: \$9.50

- 15 Wild Rush Cabernet Rose, Robertson, South Africa** \$ 17.50
 Pretty pink from a family estate, this is slightly off-dry and fruity with an appetizing aroma and refreshing flavour of raspberries and redcurrants and a lovely clean finish. 175ml glass: \$4.75
- 16 Willowglen Semillon Chardonnay, SE Australia** \$ 19.50
 Brilliant lemon green, this wine exhibits a stylish nose of elegant, lemony Semillon and the light complexing buttery notes of malolactic fermentation. The palate shows an abundance of citrus and melon flavours coupled with light spicy wood and creamy lees ageing characters. 175ml glass: \$5.25
- 17 Pinot Grigio San Antonio, Veneto,** \$ 18.50
 A clean, well balanced dry white with a delicate, elegant perfume and fresh apple fruit. It has subtle peach and pear flavours which linger on the finish. 175ml glass: \$5.25

Loire Wines

- 18 Muscadet Sur Lie, Domaine Herbauges, Côtes de Grandlieu** \$ 22.00
 Muscadet is widely produced around the town of Nantes in the western Loire. These are crisp, refreshing dry wines, ideal with seafood. The Côtes de Grandlieu is considered a superior region of Muscadet producing intense, almost exotic fruit with the rich bread-like character added by ageing over winter on the wine's lees.
- 19 Sancerre, Domaine Merlin Cherrier** \$ 29.50
 Thierry Merlin-Cherrier's Sancerre combines typical firm structure with an aromatic leafy, blackcurrant character and an extra richness of gooseberry and lees on a long, zesty finish.
- 20 Pouilly Blanc Fume, Domaine Belair** \$ 32.00
 The winemaking at this family-owned estate is thoroughly modern and the resulting blend is consistent with typical rich aromas of nettles, gooseberry and minerals followed on the palate by good weight of fruit and acidity and flinty finish.

Vins de Alsace

- 22 Pinot Blanc, Paul Zinck** \$ 23.95
 The young and dynamic winemaker, Philippe Zinck, has developed a modern approach to his family estate using grapes selected from the best limestone vineyards. This easy drinking wine has fresh apple and mineral flavours with good weight yet it is soft and supple on the palate and finishes with firm acidity.

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Burgundy White

- 24 **Pouilly Fuisse, Domaine Auvigue** half bottles: £ 17.50
 Dry white Burgundy, lightly oaked, medium bodied, with a lovely balance of mineral fruit flavours and light spice.
- 25 **Mâcon Blanc Villages, Caves de Lugny** \$24.50
 State of the art temperature control and vinification facilities have enabled the winemakers at the Caves de Lugny to capture the crisp Chardonnay flavours and ripe fruit from this southern Burgundy producer. It is aged in stainless steel with no oaking to mask the delicious clean fruit.
- 26 **Bourgogne Aligote, Domaine du Prieure** \$26.00
 White Burgundy made from the Aligoté grape variety is increasingly rare, especially in the area of Savigny where Pinot Noir and Chardonnay dominate. It is a fresh, easy drinking white with good balance and lively acidity, which makes it a fine accompaniment to seafood or on its own as an aperitif.
- 27 **St Veran, 'Moulin du Pont'. Domaine Auvigue** \$29.00
 Jean Auvigue is one of the most highly respected specialists of Pouilly in the south of Burgundy. This is a delicious Chardonnay, oak aged dry white sourced from chalk rich vineyards which tower above the famous towns of Pouilly and Fuissé. It has a full, ripe, buttery character with a fresh and supple balance.
- 28 **Chablis, Domaine Alain Gautheron** \$31.25
 This is very traditional Chablis, it has fresh, floral aromas, appely fruit and complex, rich mineral character. Fermentation and maturation is very traditional, avoiding wood to preserve the fresh steely flavours and subtle influence of the chalky vineyard soils.
- 30 **Chablis Premier Cru Fourchaume, Domaine Nathalie & Gilles Fevre** \$42.95
 A brief ageing on the lees is complemented by a small percentage of barrique-aged wine to add complexity. The nose is intense with floral, apple and bread aromas and a strong mineral influence that continues on the palate. It is rich and intense with green apple, plum and subtle lemony acidity.

Italian White

- 33 **Frascati Superiore, Fontella, Latium** \$21.50
 A crisp dry wine with delicate bouquet of peach, pineapple and passion fruit. Medium bodied with a good balance of fruit and acidity, with a concentrated finish
- 35 **Soave Classico Villa Piazzola, Fabiano, Veneto** \$23.50
 The Classico wine is the heart of the region, planted with Garganega, Trebbiano and Chardonnay and producing the best Soaves. 'Villa Piazzola' has a typical hazelnut and almond nose with a soft, dry palate of concentrated apple and pear flavours.
- 36 **Gavi di Gavi, Cantine Volpi, Piedmont** \$28.50
 Dry wine produced from Cortese grapes, with aromas of peaches, citrus and flowers and a finely textured palate with lovely balance.

New World White

- 40 **Backsberg Estate Chenin Blanc, Westner Western Cape, South Africa** \$21.00
 Backsberg strive to capture, lemony crispness and green apple fruit flavours, whilst retaining an array of aromatic characters. This fantastic example has ripe fruit, tempered by finely balanced acidity to give a mouth filling, yet refreshing palate which has a lingering finish.
- 41 **Wairau River Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** \$26.50
 A classic expression of the dry, gooseberry, grass and passion fruit style of Sauvignon that has made Marlborough world-famous, from a renowned pioneer family estate in the region.
- 42 **La Playa Reserve Chardonnay, Colchagua Valley, Chile** \$24.00
 Aromas of papaya, asparagus and apricot. In the mouth the fresh flavours take on an element of luscious peach and pineapple. The wine is well balanced and medium bodied with a long and pleasant finish.

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Rosé Wine

- 45 **Cabernet Rosé, Domaine du Grand Mayne, France** £ 20.00
A dry, fruity rosé, produced by a single estate in the Côtes de Duras region near Bordeaux. It should be drunk cool and enjoyed with salads, pates, cold meats or even salmon and grilled vegetables.

Red House Wine

- 46 **Concha y Toro Merlot, Central Valley, Chile** £ 17.50
Medium bodied with smooth cherry and raspberry flavours.
half bottle: £9.50
175ml glass: £4.75
- 48 **Willowglen Shiraz, SE Australia** £ 19.50
Brick red in colour, this wine exhibits plummy fruit aromas with hints of cassis, liquorice and underlying toasty wood characters. A medium to full-bodied style, the palate shows plum and blackcurrant fruit with a touch of bacon and oak, complemented by a long, flavoursome finish.

Rhone Red

- 50 **Cotes du Rhone, Domaine Amandine** £ 23.35
A fresh and vibrantly fruity Southern Rhône blend, which is made predominantly from Syrah with the addition of Grenache, Carignan and Cinsault. The spice and smoky aromas of the Syrah dominate the bouquet, whilst red fruits and spice compete on the palate.
- 51 **Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Saint-Paul** £ 66.00
Predominantly blended from Grenache with Syrah, Muscardin, Cinsault and Mouvèdre adding structure and complexity with an alluring intense bouquet of wild herbs, leather and pepper.

Bordeaux Red

- 53 **Château Bel Air, Bordeaux Superieur** £ 22.50
This excellent Petit Château is located on terraces overlooking the Gironde River and this wine is a blend of 50% each of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grapes. This is a classic claret with ripeness and finesse from a superb micro-climate of influences from its position above the river.
- 54 **Château Gachon, Montagne St Emilion** £ 26.50
Rich, black coloured wine which develops a fresh and fruity nose (blueberry with a hint of raw prune). On the palate, a silk and fruity attack is beautifully balanced by a structure defined by its finesse. A generous and charming wine, good length.
- 56 **Château Cabans, Cru Bourgeois, Medoc** £ 29.50
A modern interpretation of a traditional Bordeaux blend of 70% Cabernet Sauvignon and 30% Merlot grapes. The fruit is soft, ripe and appealing, balanced by supple, ripe tannins. Exotic blackcurrant, cherry and chocolate flavours lift the palate, finishing warm and raisiny.
- 59 **Château Pavil de Luze, Cru Bourgeois, Margaux** £ 52.00
A soft and alluring style, both spicy and perfumed on the nose and opulent on the palate. This is classic elegant Margaux wine with great finesse and character, with redcurrant flavours and a soft silky finish.
- 60 **Château Latour, 1er Cru Classé, Pauillac** £ 550.00
A classic with great finesse. Very deep colour reflecting the immense structure and highly concentrated flavour. Typical of '78 vintage and Latour's powerful style.

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Languedoc

- 61 Corbières Château Fabre** **\$25.00**
 This wine is concentrated with the fragrance of wild herbs and red fruits on the nose, summer fruits and woodland hints on the palate, backed by subtle oaky spice and soft ripe tannins.

Burgundy Red

- 62 Beaujolais Villages, Chateau de Nety** **\$23.25**
 Dry, fruity wine produced from Gamay grapes grown on the granite-rich slopes of the Beaujolais Villages appellation in Southern Burgundy. A very attractive, light red with supple and generous fruit flavours.
- 63 Fleurie la Madone, Georges Blanc** **\$29.00**
 A good example from this most popular of the Beaujolais Cru. The name Fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine.
- 64 Brouilly Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Dubost** **half bottles: \$ 17.50**
 Produced from 80 year old Gamay vines, this cru Beaujolais has a lovely aroma of vibrant red fruits with intense fruit flavours balanced by rounded tannins.
- 65 Savigny les Beaune, 'les Gollardes', Domaine du Prieure** **\$41.00**
 From the village of Savigny in the Côte de Beaune, Jean Michel Maurice takes pride in preserving the subtle influence of the terroir and pure essence of Pinot from the surrounding vignoble. This elegant perfumed Savigny preserves the complex raspberry fruit flavours, mineral character and power inherited from the iron rich soil.
- 66 Volnay, Domaine Lucien Boillot** **\$56.25**
 Traditional oak aged Volnay with a lovely aroma reminiscent of raspberries tinged with spice with voluptuous fruit and texture on the palate and a long finish.
- 67 Nuits St Georges 'Vieilles Vignes', Domaine Alain Michelot** **\$62.00**
 It has considerable weight, extraction, ripe fruit character and big, soft tannins, all contributing to a long satisfying finish.
- 68 Charmes Chambertin Grand Cru Domaine Geantet-Pansiot** **\$ 195.00**
 A heady bouquet of sweet violets and mineral nuances is followed by flavours of cherry and blackberries. Full and round on the tongue, it has lingering complex flavours and just the right hint of firmness from subtle silky tannins.

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Italian Reds

- 69 **Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Gavioli, Tuscany** \$26.00
 Ruby red, blend of Prugnolo Gentile and Merlot grapes, aged in oak, full flavoured, well structured, with sweet tannins.
- 70 **Valpolicella Classico Superiore Villa Piazzola, Fabiano** \$25.00
 The vineyards are situated to the north of Verona on hills sloping down to the Adige River. This is a subtle and easy drinking cherry scented red wine produced from the three Valpolicella grape varieties of Corvina Veronese, Rondinella and Molinara, which are grown on pergola trained vines.
- 71 **Salice Salentino Riserva Rione dei Dogi, Puglia** \$23.50
 A soft, full-flavoured red. It is perhaps the best-known appellation of the region for its inviting fruit character, blending local varieties Negroamaro and Malvasia Nera. Its distinctive plum and chocolate character has an attractive underlying leather and mineral flavour and subtle bitterness on the finish.
- 72 **Chianti Superiore, Donatella Colombini, Trequanda, Tuscany** \$29.50
 A well-structured wine rounded with maturation in large oak barrel. It is full bodied, with good fresh fruit, a touch of oak and a bittersweet finish.
- 73 **Barolo, Araldica Castel Boglione, Piedmont 2006** \$34.00
 A rich and powerful wine which is velvety on the palate with the distinct bouquet of roses, violets and tar.
- 74 **Rosso di Montalcino Donatella Colombini** \$45.00
 The nose is wonderfully fragrant with red berries, spice and herbs whilst the rich and vibrant palate offers hints of black cherry and mineral with a warm, opulent and very long finish.
- 75 **Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Superiore Rugola, Fabiano** \$49.00
 Full bodied with a luxurious mouth-feel. On the palate there are notes of sour cherries with hints of ripe plum, cinnamon and spices. This is beautifully structured wine with very soft tannins and gentle acidity.
- 76 **Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Tommasi, Veneto** \$68.00
 Top Amarone from a renowned family producer. Rich, voluptuous, oak aged, with complex ripe cherries and spice aroma giving way to a beautifully balanced, richly textured palate.

Spanish Red

- 78 **Cabernet Merlot Tempranillo Bodegas Asensio, Navarra** \$23.50
 Briefly aged in oak for a six month period to give balance, the wine preserves the vibrant and supple fruit character. The fruit character dominates the wine, unlike neighbouring Rioja, which generally reflects the oak flavours of the casks that are used for extended maturation.
- 79 **Rioja Reserva Bodegas Ramon Bilbao** \$32.00
 Carefully selected from the vineyards in the Rioja Alta with 20 months of ageing in American oak casks as well as further ageing in the cellar, this wine displays deep cherry red colours with aromas of cedar, blackberries, leather and spices. Good balance on the palate with a long finish

New World Red

- 82 **Merlot La Playa, Colchagua Valley, Chile** \$19.50
 This excellent red has all the rich supple plummy fruit flavours that have made this variety so popular. Good aromatic intensity and richness of black fruits like black plum, leading to notes of menthol and fresh red berry fruits. In the mouth it is creamy and round, with soft tannins and a long, savoury finish.
- 83 **ES Vino Malbec Finca Sopenia, Mendoza, Argentina** \$23.50
 Malbec is the flagship red varietal of Argentina producing a richly flavoured, attractive and easy drinking wine with ripe plum and cherry fruit flavours. A lingering palate of black fruits and supple, firm tannins.
- 84 **Pinot Noir Saurus Patagonia Select Familia Schroeder, Patagonia, Argentina** \$32.00
 Deep red tones to the eye and the nose has plenty of floral aromas, like roses and violets combined with red fruit scents such as red currants, raspberries and strawberries. Mushrooms and mineral aromas stand out together with some vanilla and cocoa notes. This medium-bodied Pinot Noir presents ultrafine tannins and fruity nuances that wave through a finish of superior depth and dimension.
